oggetto Notes on Prof. Dr. Ryszard G. Strużak prepared by Prof.
Ing. Claudio Egidì

I know Professor R.G. Strużak since about ten years, due to our common interest and activity in the field of E.M.C., a field initially restricted to a rather limited number of specialists and not yet exploded as it is now.

His uncommon interest and competency in this special branch of radio engineering allowed me to read and appreciate more and more his contributions to man-made noise investigation and suppression, a subject of increasing importance as years go by.

In my position of member of the Prize Awards Committee of the EMC Symposia, held successively at Montreux, Rotterdam and Zurich, I remember that Professor Strużak with unanimous decision received two Prize Awards for papers presented at the 1st and 2nd Symposium (1975 and 1977).

It must be remarked also his important contribution to the CCIR activity, being Professor Strużak since about ten years Vice-Chairman of Study Group 1, on Spectrum Utilization and Monitoring. Recalling my personal cooperation with CCIR, lasted thirty years with various responsibilities, I can confirm the mutual usefulness of this cooperation for the International Committee from one side and for a Professor and his School from the other side, as a practical way to progress in the various technical branches of radiocommunications. This was and is surely the case for him.

Professor Strużak is also a promoting member of EMC Symposia held in Wrocław, Poland. In a particularly strong and successful effort to overcome various difficulties, he and his cooperators succeeded in this initiative, wisely interleaving—during the even years—their Polish Symposia with the above recalled Symposia, now held in Zurich during the odd years. In this way, once in Western and another time in Eastern Europe, a yearly continuity is ensured to EMC Technical and Scientific Meetings in our Continent.

He is also a Coauthor of a very good book, published first in Polish and then in English with the name of Prof. Rotkiewicz, this book being one of the few specific texts of EMC existing in the world.

Professor Strużak is particularly able to present the subjects of his papers in a clear and pleasant style, so to attract the listener, without failing the correctness of treatment. I believe that the same style will be appropriately used by him during his lectures at the University. May I say that I appreciate very much this ability, that should be but not always is-peculiar of any teacher.

Last but not least, may I remark the uncommon kindness and politeness of Professor Strużak in his relations with his Friends and Colleagues.
