Some notes on Professor R.G.Struzak

I have known professor Struzak for over 12 years. First because of his work in C.I.S.P.R. and C.C.I.R., later because of our cooperation in the Wroclaw EMC Symposia. Professor Struzak is one of the very few professor in Electrical Engineering, who is also an authority in electromagnetic compatibility, a relatively new branch of electrical engineering. As such he would be an asset to the electrical engineering faculty of most technical universities. He is also an authority on electrical measurements, and frequency management. The international appreciation of his work is shown by his vice-chairman-ship of CCIR Study Group I. When a new chairman had to be appointed, many liked to put him up as first candidate, but he declined the offer In the Western European EMC Symposia professor Struzak is an

honored author, who always is high on the list of authors, who are in line for a distinction. If I remember well, he was elected twice for

a prize or a honourable mention.

Professor Struzak is also chairman of an CCIR Working Party(international) on ISM interference. I think, he will be able to bring this work to a successful end. Professor Struzak was perhaps the first organizer of an international symposium on electromagnetic compatibility in Europe. He and has coworkers built up a very good reputation for the international EMC Symposia in Wroclaw, of which he was many years the chairman. In view of the geographical situation, it asked for quite an effort to make it attractive to specialist from east and west alike.

Professor Struzak was coauthor of a wellknown book on electromagnetic compatibility, that first appeared in polish and later was translated into english, because of its internationally acclaimed quality.

Professor Struzak's many international contacts know him well as a proficient lecturer in the english language. Any university can profit from his presence. I recom end him strongly. T. Down H. M. Stumpers
