Struzak with whom I have been closely associated through the URSI (International Union of Radio Science) and EMC (Electromagnetic Compatibility) communities since 1979. For a series of the International Wroclaw EMC Symposia in 1980, 1982, and 1984 where he was the Symposium Chairman, I served as an organizer/chairman of invited special topical sessions created by him besides regular sessions which have won a good reputation every biennial symposia.
